Lassioglossum (Chilalictus) lanarium, 25 Halictid Bees on Podolepis jacioides Showy Copper-wire Daisy.



Porrostoma rhipidium Long-nosed Lycid Netwinged Beetle on Leptospermum obovatum Blunt-leaf Teatree



*Eryngium ovinum* Blue Devil. A perennial herb which renews from the base each spring.





Harpobittacus australis Hanging Fly on Leptospermum obovatum Blunt-leaved Teatree. It awaits its prey.



*Phyllotocus sp.* Nectar Scarab on *Ammobiuma latum* Winged Everlasting.



Heteronympha merope Common Brown Butterfly on Callistemon sieberi River Bottlrbrush..



Swainsona galegifolia Smooth Darling Pea. A tall growing attractive perennial pea, good for gardens.



Polystichum proliferum Mother Shield Fern. A hardy cool climate terrestrial fern of east coast of Australia.



Cullen macrocephalum Dusky Scurf-pea. A trailing perennial herb found in the southeast of NSW.
